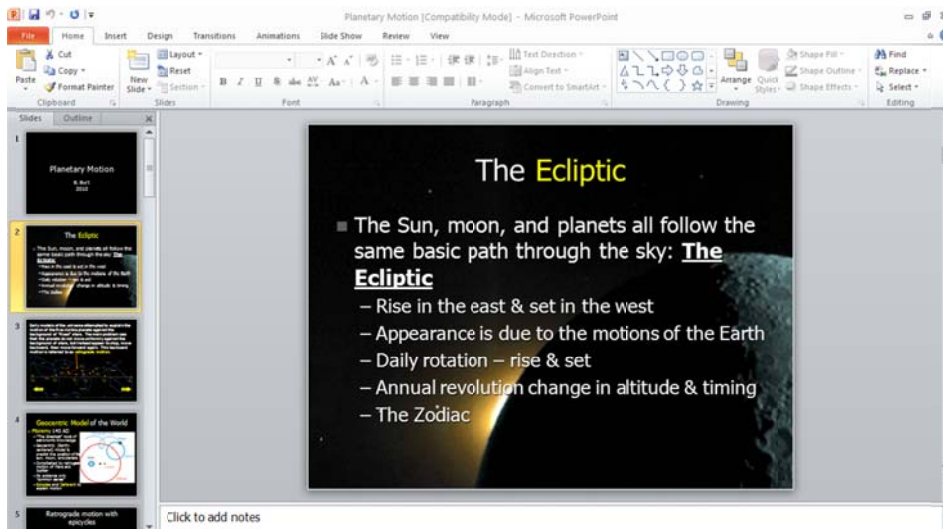
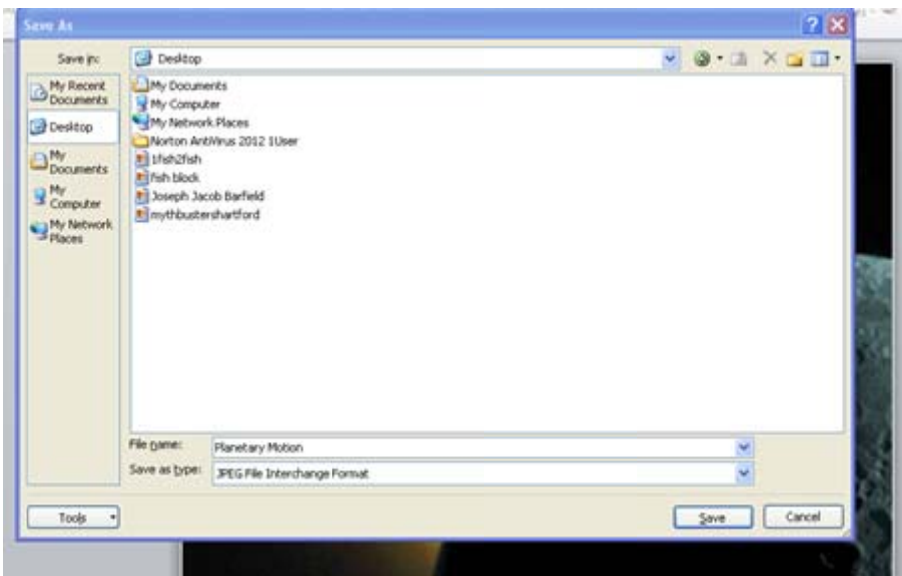


# How to use PowerPoint Slides in Windows Movie Maker

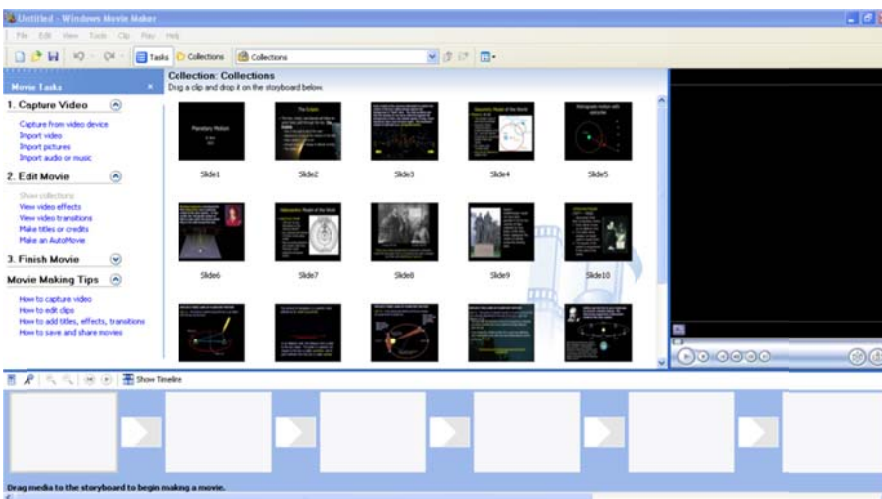
Using PowerPoint to create tables, charts, wordy text, or text picture combinations is a great idea. Converting these PowerPoint slides is a breeze in WMM2.6. Since WMM supports video, audio and pictures as input files, the PowerPoint slides must be saved as images first so that they can be “imported” into WMM.



Create the slides you need in PowerPoint, and save them initially as a PowerPoint file [.ppt or .pptx].



Save it again in your Solar System Project file folder as a .JPG file (image file). Select “Every Slide” if you wish to convert all to individual .JPG files.



Open WMM2.6, select “Import Pictures” and import all the .JPG files you just created into your “Collection”.



Choose where to incorporate these images into your movie by dragging them into the timeline (or storybook) view.



Add transitions between the images as you would for any image.
